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PRE / POST TOUR

GOLDEN TRIANGLE

DELHI – AGRA – JAIPUR



Day 1: Arrival in Delhi

Introduction to India's Capital

Morning: Arrive at Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi. Meet and greet at the airport, followed by hotel check-in and some rest after the flight.

Afternoon: Begin with a visit to Humayun's Tomb, a UNESCO World Heritage site and architectural inspiration for the Taj Mahal. Continue to Qutub Minar, the tallest brick minaret in the world.

Evening: Drive past India Gate and Rashtrapati Bhavan (Presidential Palace) for photo stops.

*Day 2: Old Delhi

Heritage & Cultural Immersion

Morning: Explore Old Delhi with a guided rickshaw ride through Chandni Chowk. Visit Jama Masjid, one of India's largest mosques, and stop by Raj Ghat, the memorial of Mahatma Gandhi.

Afternoon: Visit Lotus Temple (Bahá'í House of Worship) and Akshardham Temple, known for its intricate carvings and cultural exhibits.

Evening: Optional: Attend a sound & light show at Red Fort or enjoy a street food tasting tour in Old Delhi for an authentic local experience.



Day 3: Delhi to Agra

(Approx. 4 hours by car)

Morning: Depart early for Agra via the Yamuna Expressway. On arrival, check into your hotel.

Afternoon: Visit Agra Fort, a UNESCO site showcasing Mughal grandeur. Later, explore Mehtab Bagh, the garden across the Yamuna River offering a perfect sunset view of the Taj Mahal.



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Day 4: Taj Mahal

Drive to Jaipur (Approx. 5 hours)

Early Morning: Visit the Taj Mahal at sunrise — the best time for photography and to experience its serene beauty. Return to the hotel for breakfast.

Late Morning: Depart for Jaipur, stopping en route at Fatehpur Sikri, the abandoned Mughal capital known for its red sandstone architecture.

Evening: Arrive in Jaipur and check into your hotel. Enjoy a relaxed evening at leisure or explore the local bazaar for handicrafts and textiles.

Day 5: Jaipur

The Pink City Experience

Morning: Visit Amber Fort, including an optional elephant or jeep ride to the fort entrance. Explore its courtyards, mirror palace, and panoramic views.

Afternoon: Stop at Jal Mahal (Water Palace) for photos, then visit City Palace and Jantar Mantar, the royal observatory.

Evening: Stroll through Johari Bazaar for gemstones and traditional jewellery.



Day 6: Jaipur Departure

(Approx. 4 hours by car)

Morning: Depending on flight timing, visit Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds) for a quick photo stop.

Afternoon: Transfer to Jaipur Airport for onward travel.
